



Pine Rivers State High School

Enrolment Management Plan

In 2004, Pine Rivers State High School was required to develop and implement an Enrolment Management Plan in order to ensure that the enrolment demand did not exceed the capacity of the school facilities. The plan was developed by the School Council in consultation with parents, local secondary principals and feeder primary school principals. The implementation of the plan successfully contained our Year 8 enrolment to 10 classes for 2005 and 2006.

In 2007, there will be capacity for up to 12 Year 8 classes. We believe that this should ensure that all children whose families wish them to enrol will be accepted, whether they live in the catchment area or not.

The Enrolment Management Plan for enrolment for 2007 will be enacted in accordance with the Department of Education's Admission Policy and is as follows:

Category A

All students in Years 8 – 12 who reside within the local catchment area (LCA) have the right to enrolment.

Students identified by the Department of Education ascertainment / education adjustment support processes as special needs students with recommended placement at Pine Rivers State High School will be enrolled in the Special Education Unit.

Category B

There will be significant spare capacity in 2007. Students will need to complete an application based on our Teaching and Learning Culture. Students will need to demonstrate a genuine commitment to fit in with the school's ethos in their application, which will be considered based on the following criteria and order of priority:

1. Students whose parents or legal guardian are employed by / in / at the school
2. Siblings of currently enrolled students living outside the Local Catchment Area
3. Students living outside the Local Catchment Area who, in Year 7 attend schools with whom Pine Rivers SHS has a traditional primary feeder relationship (Strathpine, Lawnton, Petrie, Kurwongbah, Undurba, Dayboro, Bray Park, Strathpine West, Kallangur, Bald Hills, Our Lady of the Way, Holy Spirit)
4. Students who in Year 7 attend a school in the Sunshine Coast South District who can demonstrate an alignment with our Teaching and Learning Culture.

The principal of the primary school which the child attends will sign the application form to indicate that the student has completed same.

The Applications will be forwarded to primary schools on Friday, July 21 and must be received at Pine Rivers State High School by **Friday August 25**. Enrolment confirmations will be posted by Friday, September 8.

Enrolment Information

Pine Rivers State High School's annual EXPO will be conducted on Wednesday July 19 from 4pm until 7pm at which enrolment information will be available and the principal will address interested visitors to explain the plan.

The principal and deputy principal Year 8 2007 have explained enrolment procedures to Year 7 students at a series of visits to primary schools towards the end of Term 2. This has been conducted in association with the other Pine Rivers State Secondary Schools in our area.

All students who wish to enrol at Pine Rivers State High School for 2007 are encouraged to make application by August 25, 2006.
