RISK:	This is a low-risk activity.
STAFFING:	As per the tutoring timetable which can be found on the Pine Rivers State High School website, student Compass newsfeed and displayed outside the Mathematics staffroom.
VOLUNTEERS:	Not required.
TRANSPORT:	Parents/carers are requested to ensure students have transport organised after they depart tutoring.
DRESS CODE:	School uniform.
BEHAVIOUR:	Students are expected to adhere to the Student Code of Conduct at all times.
PRECAUTIONS:	Nil.
STUDENTS WITH A DISABILITY:	Parents/carers are requested to contact their Mathematics teacher with any additional adjustments that may be required for their child while attending tutoring.
