Dear Parents and Guardians,

Pine Rivers State High School is pleased to offer the 2026 Year 7, 10 and newly enrolled families the opportunity to participate in our School Managed/Owned Device (SMOD) Laptop Program. This program has been designed to provide students with reliable, high-quality laptops that are fully supported by the school and ready for use in the classroom. The SMOD Program operates as an additional Student Resource Scheme from the general SRS for textbooks, classroom resources, and equipment.

Program Overview - Standard Laptop - Years 7, 10 and newly enrolled students

- Cost: \$389.40 (GST inclusive) per year for 3 year agreement
- Included: ASUS Rugged clamshell 14" BR1402C Laptop, designed to handle teenage behaviour

Performance Laptop – Year 10+ only – For video/image editing and AutoCAD classes

- Cost: \$427.90 (GST inclusive) per year for 3 year agreement
- Included: Dell Pro 14" PC14250 laptop, Iris-XE Graphics chip, a powerful device for careful students

Both models come with charger, carry case, 3-year warranty, accidental damage protection, and full on-site IT support. Ownership: The laptop is rented through the school during the program and becomes the family's property at the end of the 3-year term or upon early payout (as outlined in the Enrolment Book).

Actions Required by Parents/Guardians

- 1. Complete, sign, and return the SMOD Program Participation Agreement to the school by 2 November 2025, along with a non-refundable \$100 deposit, to secure the correct number of devices for ordering.
- 2. An invoice will be issued once enrolment is confirmed and all documents are returned.

Please note: The first instalment must be paid in full before a student can collect their device.

- 3. Payments can be made using the methods outlined on the invoice.
