Pine Rivers SHS is committed to our continual improvement in our reading, writing and numeracy student outcomes as evidenced in our Year 7 and 9 NAPLAN results.

For 2017 our measurable targets are:

- Above 95% NMS for Grade 7 and 9 Reading results in this year's NAPLAN test
- Above 22% U2B for Grade 7 and 9 Reading results in this year's NAPLAN test
- Above 90% NMS for Grade 7 and 9 Writing results in this year's NAPLAN test
- Above 15% U2B for Grade 7 and 9 Writing results in this year's NAPLAN test
- Above 96% NMS for Grade 7 and 9 Numeracy results in this year's NAPLAN test
- Above 20% U2B for Grade 7 and 9 Numeracy results in this year's NAPLAN test

The total cost of this initiative is **\$229130**


150 hours of additional teacher aide support has been employed to assist teachers in the areas of:
